



NOTICE OF PROCUREMENT (Small Value Procurement)

HIRING OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES (Individual) FOR THE DESCRIPTIVE STUDY ON EXISTING INTERVENTION PROGRAMS AND PUBLIC INVESTMENTS FOR CAR AND CICL

1. The Government of the Philippines (GOP), through the **Policy Research and Development Division** of the **Juvenile Justice and Welfare Council (JJWC)**, intends to apply the sum of **Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP200,000.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) as payment for the **“Hiring of Consultancy Services (Individual) for the Descriptive Study on Existing Intervention Programs and Public Investments for CAR and CICL”** (JJWC NNP No. 16-SVC-008).
2. In November 2013, RA 10630 or an Act Strengthening the Juvenile Justice System in the Philippines, Amending for the Purpose Republic Act 9344 or the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act (JJWA) of 2006, was enacted to enable the latter's full implementation. The amended JJWA strengthened community-based and center-based interventions through the establishment of Bahay Pag-asa for children below the age of criminal responsibility and provided for intense intervention for those children who commit serious crime and those who have been found to have to repeat offenses. Despite the initial milestone reached by the JJWC toward the establishment of a national information management system on CAR and CICL a year after the enactment of RA 10630, a systematic database or data sharing among implementing agencies has yet to be set up. As a state party to the Convention on the Rights of the Child, the Philippines has a legal obligation to ensure that its budget is responsive to the needs of its children. As established by the Council for the Welfare of Children's Financing for Children study, the cost of NOT investing in children is unacceptably high, and that enriched human development through early interventions alleviates poverty more sustainability. Both the World Bank and UNICEF promote investment in children for the reasons that well-developed children will be more productive and contributory citizens and that this is a foundation to an individual's health and well-being. As such, a descriptive study on existing interventions programs and public investments on CAR and CICL in the Philippines need to be conducted to: (1) determine the level of LGU investments on CAR and CICL interventions as indicated in their budget allocations of their IRA and CLJIPs; (2) determine the levels of intervention and specific services provided to CAR and CICL; (3) identify the gaps in the interventions so that corresponding policies and programs will be developed to fully respond to the needs of these children, and (4) identify advocacy opportunities and strategies to allocate more resources for CAR and CICL concerns. Thus, the need for this consultancy services (individual)

3. The Scope of Work and Functions of the Consultant are as follows:
- Assist the Council in the design and implementation of the study;
 - Draft and finalize the research design;
 - Construct the data gathering tools;
 - Leads the conduct of the study;
 - Prepare the research report, after validation and finalization with the Council.
4. The Consultant must provide the following:
- Activity design for the consultation workshop discussed and finalized
 - Facilitate TWG consultation meetings and workshop
 - Construct the data gathering tools
 - Submission of draft and finalize research design
 - Submission of research report on existing interventions programs and public investments on CAR and CICL.
5. The Consultant will be evaluated by the Policy Research and Development Division (end user) using the Quality-Based Selection (QBS) with the following criteria below:
